Match the shapes to get each person to their hometown.

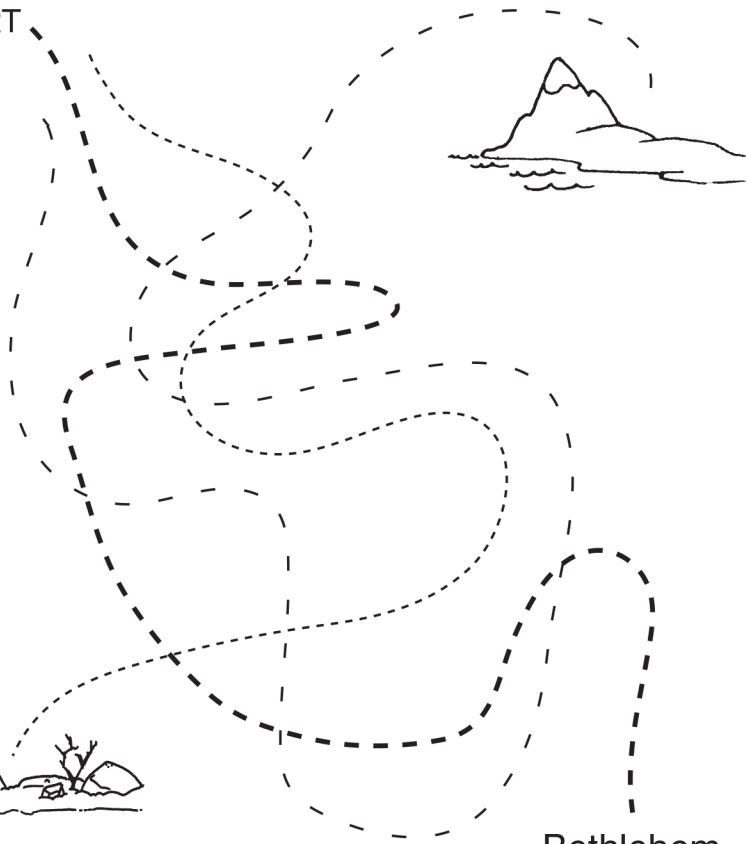
